

SHIPBOURNE FARMERS MARKET

Due to the current unprecedented situation the Farmers Market is needing to take extra precautions to protect customers, stallholders and volunteers.

The Market is held on Thursday each week and is an important source of produce for its many customers. With effect from next Thursday, 2nd April, the Market is temporarily relocating to the road in front of the village hall so that we can trial a 'drive thru' collection service enabling customers to collect pre placed orders without getting out of their cars. In addition to the drive thru the Parish Council have organised a team of volunteers to deliver market produce to those isolating and unable to go out.

Drive thru

It is intended that volunteer marshals will be on hand to direct traffic and customers. A one way system will be introduced whilst the Market is open, with customers turning into the road off Upper Green Road, goods for collection will be held pre-packaged in a gazebo on the footpath to the hall and volunteers will load the produce into each car as it pulls up at the end of the pathway. Cars will then continue back onto Upper Green Road using the slip road by the post box.

We are trying to organise customers to arrive during a pre-allocated time slot so that congestion is minimised. If you have been advised of a time slot, please do try to keep to that time.

If you are ONLY collecting an order please do follow the signs, the marshal's instructions and do not get out of your car.
