Minutes of the AGM and Parish meeting at 7.30 p.m. on Monday 9 May 2022

Present: Cllr Tyler (Chair), Cllr Redman (Vice Chair), Cllr Bate, Cllr Dagger, Cllr Leach, Cllr Oram, Cllr Sheldrick and The Parish Clerk and 2 members of the public.

- 1. Apologies for absence Cllr Taylor
- 2. To Elect Chair Cllr Tyler was proposed by Cllr Bate and seconded by Cllr Oram Agreed
- 3. To Elect Vice Chair Cllr Redman was proposed by Cllr Tyler and seconded by Cllr Sheldrick Agreed
- 4. To Elect Parish Representatives:
 - **4.1. KALC** Cllr Bate was proposed by Cllr Tyler and seconded by Cllr Redman. The Clerk said that she would be attending meetings as she was the Secretary. Agreed.
 - **4.2. PPP –** It was suggested that Councillors attend on a rota agreed.
 - **4.3. Village Hall Committee –** Cllr Leach and The Clerk are Trustees of the Village Hall Committee and should continue to represent the Parish Council agreed
- 5. Dispensations and Declarations of Interest Cllr Sheldrick declared an interest in Ambleside.
- The Minutes of the Parish Council meeting 4 April 2022 were agreed and signed as a true record.
- 7. Public Open Session A member of public attended the meeting to raise some concerns at Dunks Green:
 - 1. In the Minutes of the March meeting, it was stated that the hedge at Dunks Green shouldn't be cut, however, several residents would like the hedge to be cut so that the views could be enjoyed. Cllr Bate said that the reasons for not cutting were so that the Little Mead could not be seen and to avoid it looking like an "urban" hedge in the woodland setting. It was agreed that the hedge should mark the woodland edge with a view at the lower end. The hedge is currently at a good height so when it grows, the height can be reduced but without making it look too manicured. The hedge should be allowed to grow in width. The Clerk will contact Geoff Taylor to let him know.
 - 2. The hedge along the boundary with Long Mill Lane is encroaching onto the road which is also a bus route and needs to be cut back to allow safe access for the double decker buses. It was agreed that the Clerk should contact Duncan Simpson and ask him to take all the arisings.
 - 3. There is an ongoing issue with foul water on Dunks Green The Clerk reported that she had contacted both South East Water and Southern Water who had both been out to test the water and it is neither fresh or waste water. South East Water though that the water was run off from one of the farmers' fields. It was agreed that the Clerk should pursue the water companies and try and set up a meeting to try and establish the source. This should also be taken up with the Environment Agency at TMBC. Cllr Bate suggested that the Clerk should approach Cllr Taylor as he has had dealings with SE Water.
- 8. Highways & Footpaths Highways Improvement Plan (HIP) Site meeting with Clare Venner from Kent Highways scheduled for 23rd May, Cllr Tyler, Cllr Oram and Clerk to attend. The Clerk had received a response from PCSO regarding parking on double yellow lines to say that the Police wouldn't be able to follow up, we can pick this up with Claire Venner.
- 9. Matters arising
 - 9.1. Grass Cutting at Wightwicks and Common Land at Dunks Green 2022 The Clerk reported that she had received an email from The Rifleman requesting that the grass is cut for an event to celebrate the Jubilee. It was agreed that the Clerk should write back to ask for a formal request to use the space with details about the event so that we can instruct Geoff Taylor to cut the grass, on this occasion, the arisings should be taken away.
 - **9.2. Broken sign post at Dunks Green –** Sign not yet installed Cllr Sheldrick will follow up.
